Update on Workers Memorandum Submission

This serves as a reminder on the impending response with regard to the submitted memorandum by Ex-Transnet Workers on the 7th June 2017 at Transnet Queens office in Durban. The memorandum was submitted by workers and accepted on behalf of Transnet by Bheki Gumede and Shepard Duma as Senior Managers, and Bhekinkosi Ngubo Signed on behalf of workers.

On the same breath the workers believe that Transnet leadership treats this matter with the urgency it deserves and would want to find an amicable solution. And it is on this spirit that workers makes this submission as the reminder to what was entailed in the content of the memorandum, mainly that Transnet commits to refer the matter to the senior management to explore the matter further, and to report back to workers after seven (7) days. To date seven (7) lapsed yesterday, and workers have not received from Transnet any correspondence.

At this point in time workers do not know where to go for an update on progress on how far the memorandum has gone in terms of attending their grievances. Further delays would aggravate matters and aggrieve workers, as such behavior would mean workers grievances are look at askance, regardless how the crisis directly affects workers immediate families.

Your consideration and response to our submission will be highly appreciated.
