
IGI APPOINTMENT

Your letters dated 3 and 19 October 2016 refer. In that context, I would like to respond as follows:

1. The Joint Standing Committee on Intelligence (JSCI) is prioritising the appointment of an Inspector General of Intelligence and has resolved to do all that is necessary to recommend a candidate to the National Assembly by mid-November. To this end, shortlisting and interviews will closely follow the closing date of the advert.
2. We once again confirm our previous communication that shortlisting and interviews will be held in an open session. The dates and venues for these sessions will be published in the Z-list in due course.
3. The curriculum vitae will be placed before the committee in accordance with Rule 17(3) of Schedule B of the Joint Rules. Rule 17(1) provides that documents before the committee are not open to the public. Curriculum vitae are of such a nature that their confidential treatment, especially in this process, is reasonable and justifiable in an open and democratic society.
